Paul Venables and Chris Maddock recently manned the PHS stand at the HIC 2006 in Sydney.

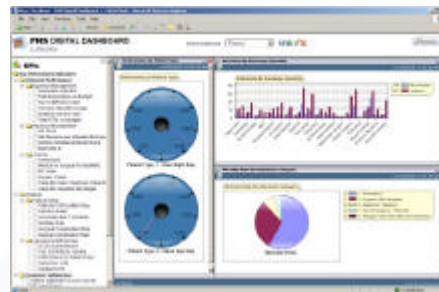

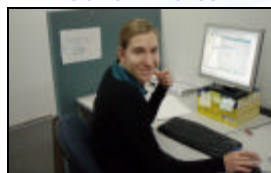
